The use of turnout is now introduced with plies. The importance of imagination based learning is maintained with imaginative movement sequences that the children help the teacher choreograph. Props also play an integral part with use of pom poms, scarves, feathers and musical instruments.

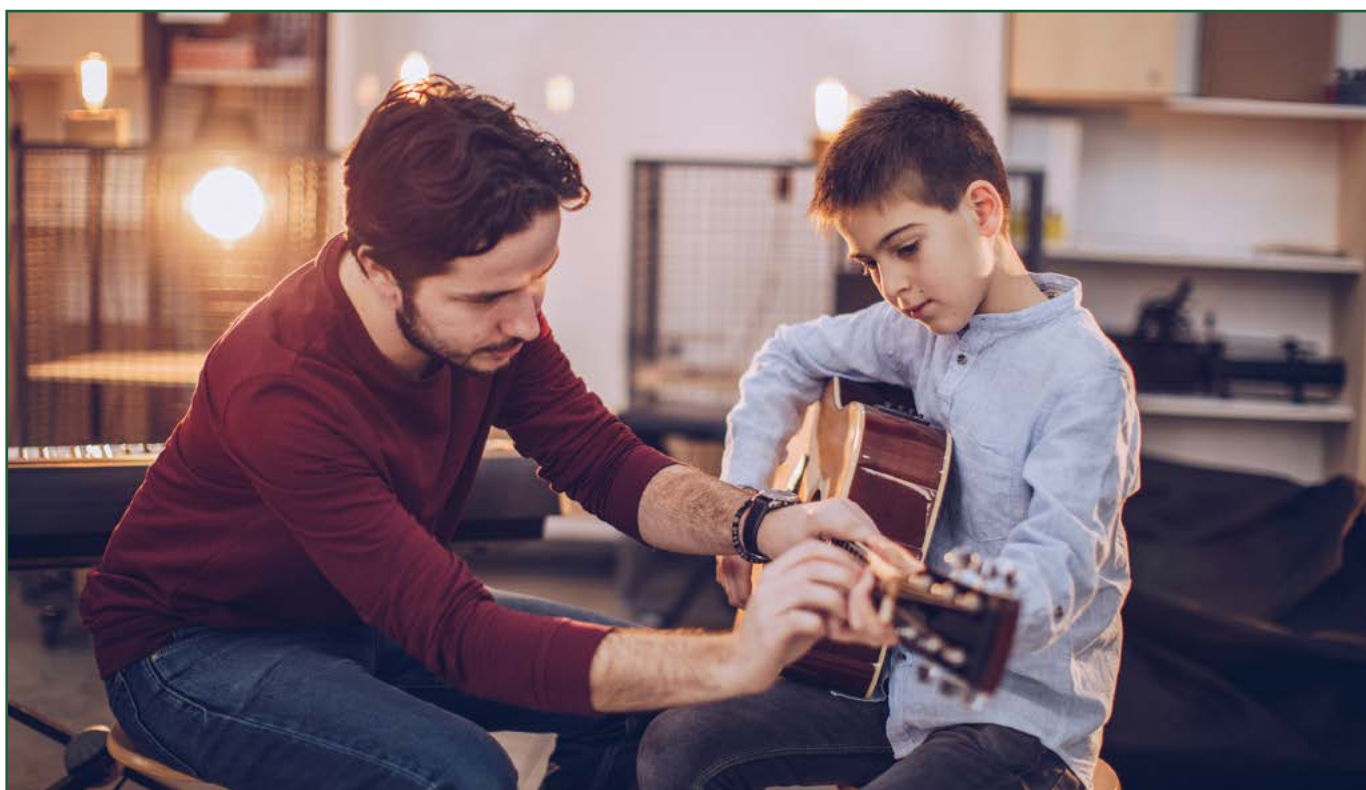
