Football

We would like to inform you of the conditions for gradually formalising the Pre-Benjamín mixed, Benjamín mixed, Alevín mixed and Alevín girls' football teams, so that they can be correctly registered in a municipal league for the 2026/27 season.

What does participating in this initiative involve?

- Passing the final selection process.
- Becoming part of the RPS Pre-Benjamín mixed, Benjamín mixed, Alevín mixed and girls', and Infantil boys' football teams for the 2026/27 season and future seasons.
- Registering in a suitable local league in all respects: location, costs and participation rules. Naturally, this will involve a cost, but it will be calculated solely to cover expenses.

League: MUNICIPAL SPORTS GAMES – HORTALEZA DISTRICT

Organised by: Madrid City Council

Type of competition and categories:

- Pre-Benjamín mixed football, born in 2019 and 2020 – Years 2 & 3 in 2026/27
- Benjamín mixed football, born in 2017/2018 – Years 4 & 5 in 2026/27
- Alevín mixed football, born in 2015/2016 – Years 6 & 7 in 2026/27
- Alevín girls' football, born in 2015/2016 – Years 6 & 7 in 2026/27
- Infantil boys' football, born in 2013/2014 – Years 8 & 9 in 2026/27

Characteristics: In accordance with the rules of the municipal 7-a-side football leagues.

Competition calendar: To be received once registration has been completed.

Competition times and days: One match per week, played on Saturdays. The time is to be confirmed. Each week will alternate between home and away matches and, in both cases, we will be assigned a pitch close to the school.

Coordinator/coach: Neil Moran. If he is unavailable, he will be replaced.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Parents must take players to the venues where matches are held with maximum punctuality. It is recommended that players arrive at least 20 minutes before the scheduled start time. If a player is unable to attend a match and/or training session, this must be communicated as far in advance as possible through the indicated channel, the WhatsApp group.

Training sessions: The school will include one weekly training session for players, which they must attend. Full commitment from both parents and players is essential for the smooth running of the team. For the 2026/27 school year, the school has planned the following official training sessions:

- Pre-Benjamín: **Fridays from 4.30 to 5.30 pm.**
- Benjamín: **Thursdays from 4.30 to 5.45 pm.**
- Alevín mixed: **Tuesdays from 4.30 to 5.45 pm.**
- Alevín girls: **Fridays from 4.30 to 5.45 pm.**
- Infantil boys: **Wednesdays from 4.30 to 5.45 pm.**

The training and friendly match calendar will run from **October to June.**

Competition days: To be defined by the organisers for 2026/27, but they are expected to begin around October/November 2026.

Maximum number of players: 16 registered players. All players must be from the school.

Minimum number of players: 10 players, in order for the league to go ahead.

Kit: A specific sports kit for this team.

Annual registration fee: €30.

Kit cost: €40 for the full kit. If individual items are required, please consult the team coordinator directly.

Basketball

What does participating in this initiative involve?

- Passing the final selection process.
- Becoming part of the RPS Benjamín or Alevín basketball team for the 2026/27 season and future seasons.
- Registering in a suitable local league in all respects: location, costs and participation rules. Naturally, this will involve a cost, but it will be calculated solely to cover expenses.

League: MUNICIPAL SPORTS GAMES – BASKETBALL

Organised by: Madrid City Council

Type of competition and categories:

- Benjamín mixed basketball, born in 2017/2018 – Years 4 & 5 in 2026/27
- Alevín mixed basketball, born in 2015/2016 – Years 6 & 7 in 2026/27

IMPORTANT NOTE: There is the possibility of forming a second Alevín mixed team depending on final demand.

Characteristics: Matches consist of four 10-minute quarters with a running clock. The clock only stops during time-outs and dead-ball situations in the final minute of the last quarter. Victory is achieved by scoring one or more points than the opposing team.

Competition calendar: To be received once registration has been completed.

Competition times and days: One match per week, played on Saturday mornings. The time is to be confirmed. Each week will alternate between home and away matches and, in both cases, we will be assigned a court close to the school.

Coordinator/coach: Julián Muñoz Sánchez. If he is unavailable, he will be replaced.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Parents must take players to the venues where matches are held with maximum punctuality. It is recommended that players arrive at least 20 minutes before the scheduled start time. If a player is unable to attend a match and/or training session, this must be communicated as far in advance as possible through the indicated channel, the WhatsApp group.

Monthly cost: From September 2026, for both Alevín and Benjamín teams: €95 per month.

Volleyball

We would like to inform you of the arrangements for forming the Benjamín (mixed), Alevín (mixed), Infantil (girls') and Cadete (girls') volleyball teams, so that they can be entered correctly in a municipal league for the 2026/27 season.

What does taking part in this initiative involve?

- Successfully completing the final selection process.
- Joining one of the RPS Benjamín (mixed), Alevín (mixed), Infantil (girls') or Cadete (girls') volleyball teams for the 2026/27 season and future seasons.
- Entering a suitable local league in terms of location, costs and participation rules. This will naturally involve a fee, calculated solely to cover expenses.

League: Escuelas Católicas de Madrid

Organised by: Escuelas Católicas de Madrid Competition formats and categories:

- Mixed Benjamín volleyball (born in 2017/2018 - Years 4 and 5 in 2026/27)
- Mixed Alevín volleyball (born in 2015/2016 - Years 6 and 7 in 2026/27)
- Girls' Infantil volleyball (born in 2013/2014 - Years 8 and 9 in 2026/27)
- Girls' Cadete volleyball (born in 2011/2012 - Years 10 and 11 in 2026/27)

* **IMPORTANT NOTE:** A second team may be formed in each category if demand allows.

Format: In accordance with the volleyball league rules for the relevant categories.

Competition calendar: To be confirmed once registration has been completed; it normally runs from late **October to late May.**

Match schedule: One match per week, played on Saturdays (time to be confirmed). Home and away fixtures will alternate each week; in both cases, a court close to the school will be allocated.

Coach/coordinator: Arancha Rivas

IMPORTANT NOTE: Parents must take players to the venues where matches are held with maximum punctuality. It is recommended that players arrive at least 20 minutes before the scheduled start time. If a player is unable to attend a match and/or training session, this must be communicated as far in advance as possible through the indicated channel, the WhatsApp group.

Training: the school will provide two training sessions per week, which players will be required to attend. The full commitment of both parents and players is essential to the successful running of the team. The official training schedule planned for the 2026-27 academic year is as follows:

- Benjamín mixed volleyball: **Tuesdays and Thursdays, 4:30 to 5:45 pm.**
- Alevín mixed volleyball: **Tuesdays and Thursdays, 4:30 to 5:45 pm.**
- Infantil girls' volleyball: **Tuesdays and Thursdays, 4.30 to 5.45 pm.**
- Cadete girls' volleyball: **Tuesdays and Thursdays, 4.30 to 5.45 pm.**
- For all age groups, an optional additional skills development training session is available on Fridays from 4.30 to 5.45 pm.

The training and friendly-match programme will run from **September to June.**

Competition fixtures: To be confirmed by the organisers for the 2026-27 season. The competition is expected to begin in October or November 2026. The schedule will be updated monthly.

Maximum number of players: 12 registered players. All players must be pupils at the school.

Minimum number of players: 8 players are required for the team to participate in the league.

Kit: A specific sports kit will be provided for the team.

Annual player registration fee: €75.

Kit cost: €130 for the full kit. If individual items are required, please consult the team coordinator directly.

Monthly cost: From September 2026, for both Alevín and Benjamín teams: €85 per month.
